- Working with TAG President to evaluate and negotiate lender and LIHTC investor terms for RAD and mixed-finance projects
- Analyzing project feasibility for mixed-finance, -income, and -use projects and providing recommendations on financial sources and project structuring
- Researching, analyzing data, and producing reports on a variety of topics related to housing development and agency-wide policies
